Top 3 in each class will receive premium and a participation ribbons will be given to all the other exhibitors.

**WORKING CLASS**

6. Working - The dog performs exercises which it has been trained to do, such as: tricks, pointing, retrieving, working with livestock, agility, fly ball, free style obedience, or other. The exercise cannot be those required in the obedience classes. Credit will be given for dogs performing exercises that show original or developed purpose of the breed. The working exercises may not exceed five minutes. Each exhibitor will provide two copies of a brief description of the performance to the show superintendent before entering the ring.
7. Showmanship - all ages.
