All Open Class needle arts can be entered from 6 to 9 P.M. Wednesday, July 9, 2008 or 7 to 10 A.M. Thursday, July 10, 2008. Exhibits will be released at 8 P. M. last day of the fair.

Clothing Items must be on hangers and covered with a clear plastic bag. Each entry must be listed in premium book to be accepted for judging. Other articles accepted for display only. All articles must be the work of the exhibitor. No article can compete for first premium more than one year. Second and third prizes can compete again for first prize. All articles must have been finished within the last two years. One entry per class number. A "Best of" ribbon will be awarded to the best overall in each division. Champion and reserve rosettes will be awarded with selections made from the "Best of" in: divisions 401 - 425 + 431 - 449; and divisions 426 - 430 (quilts).

Age Divisions: enter the appropriate division for age of exhibitor. Age divisions for needle arts are:

Youth: Under 12 years of age

Junior: 12 to 16 years of age

Adult: 17 to 64 years of age

Senior - 65: 65 to 79 years of age

Senior - 80: Over 80 years of age
